We are currently accepting high-quality assets in the following categories:

 - Must be fully operational

Items We Do Not Accept

We do not accept the following items under any circumstances:

- Unroadworthy vehicles
- Unsafe, prohibited, or banned goods
- Non-working or incomplete equipment
- Items with existing liens
- Used clothing or footwear (including jerseys, jackets, etc.)
- Used dishware, excluding antiques or fine china
- Expired items
- Low-quality or heavily worn furniture
- Items that require VINs but do not have them
- Hazardous materials without proper WHMIS labeling
- Boxes of books or magazines (excluding items from the 1900s or earlier)
- Boxes of miscellaneous or mismatched household items
- Cassette tapes and VHS tapes
- Used safety gear or helmets (all tags must be removed)
